Back to School...

In 1857, sixteen school districts were formed in Freeborn County. District No. 17 was added in February 1858. By September 1859, the number of districts had reached 45. The growth of school districts within the county continued. When the Freeborn County Superintendent of Schools filed his report for the winter term of 1881-82, there were 111 school districts. The average number of students in each was 29. In his report, Superintendent C. W. Levens outlined the "Program of Daily Exercises" for the schools.
